- > We seek to improve and raise the standard of our more than 2,000 suppliers in responsible management practices.
- > Since 2013, our logistics team seeks to know the reality of MSMEs in order to provide them with feedback and identify opportunities for improvement.
- > Since 2018, TASA works hand in hand with the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) and has created the "competitive business" program:



**9 suppliers** are trained and develop their first sustainability report.



Thanks to the success of this program, 100 are summoned for the 2019 period.

- In 2019, thanks to the support of the International Labour Organization (ILO) and the Ministry of Labor (MINTRA for its Spanish acronym), more than 100 providers were trained in the SCORE methodology.
- > An important milestone of this initiative was obtaining a S /.650,000 soles fund from the Innóvate Program for 2020.
